## Accuflo Eclipse (Elastomeric pump)

Take Medication out of refrigerator and allow to come to room temperature. Check medication label for <u>patient's name</u>, <u>medication and dose</u>, <u>expiration date</u>. **Accuflo devices** may vary in shape and size based medication and supplier.

- 1. Wash hands/ dry with paper towels
- 2. Clean your work area as instructed
- **3.** Gather supplies:
  - Medicine in Accuflo (at room temperature)
  - 2 saline flushes
  - 1-heparin flush
  - Alcohol wipes
- **4.** Wash your hands \*\*Prepare Heparin & Saline flushes by removing air from syringes , replacing cap on syringes when done.
  - 5. Unwind the tubing from the Accuflo and remove the cap on the Accuflo tubing but DO NOT LAY CAP DOWN
  - 6. Unclamp clam on tubing, allow the fluid to run to the end of the tubing.
  - 7.. Put the cap back on the end of IV tubing and clamp tubing.
  - **9.** Clean the injection cap on patient's IV catheter with alcohol x 15 seconds and flush IV catheter with Saline.
  - 10. Clean injection cap on patient's IV catheter with alcohol x 15 seconds and attach IV tubing to the injection cap on patient's IV catheter
  - 11. Unclamp the tubing, be sure ALL clamps are open.
  - **12.** When the balloon has completely collapsed on the cylinder in the center, the medicine is done.
  - **13.** Clamp the IV tubing and wash your hands.
  - 14. Disconnect IV tubing from the injection cap on patient's IV catheter.
  - 15. Clean the injection cap on IV catheter with alcohol x 15 seconds and flush with Saline.
  - **16.** Clean the injection cap on patient's IV catheter with alcohol x 15 seconds and flush with Heparin flush
  - 17. Clamp tubing on patient's IV catheter, as instructed.
  - 18. Discard empty Accuflo and syringes as instructed.
